## **Open Morning and Open Evening at Priestmead Site**

Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to inform you of the Open Morning and Evening arrangements for Salvatorian College this year.

The school will be open on the morning of Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> October for prospective parents to visit and have guided tours of the school to see our pupils engaged in lessons. Visitors are welcome from 9.15am for tours to commence at 9.30am. Mr Tissot, Executive Head Teacher, will be giving a speech at 10.30am and the Open Morning will conclude at 11.00am.

During the evening of Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> October visitors will be welcome from 5.30pm for guided tours. It will provide an opportunity for Year 5 and 6 pupils to talk to our pupils about their experiences at Salvatorian College, meet the teachers, and sample some learning activities in each department.

Mr Tissot will be making a speech in the school hall at 6.30pm and the evening will conclude at 7.30pm.

To facilitate preparation of the Priestmead site, we will on both sites close after Period 3 at 12.35pm on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> October. It is expected that Year 7 and 8 pupils volunteer to assist and lead learning activities in departments on the Priestmead site during the evening. Year 9 pupils and the wider Year 11 Prefect team will be the tour guides for parents.

School will re-open on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> October at 9.50am with breakfast available to purchase from 9.15am.

To make you aware, the next cohort of Year 7 will only be at the Priestmead site for one term before we all return to the brand new building on the Salvatorian site in January 2019. With this exciting prospect in mind, with the Good judgement from Ofsted in February 2017 and continued examination success, we are in a strong position for the future.
