Charity Fun Run

We are excited to announce that our school will be hosting a charity fun run on Wednesday, July 19th. The run will commence at 4 pm and will be held at the Bannisters Outdoor Sports Centre, Uxbridge Rd, Harrow HA3 6SW. The event will finish at approximately 5 pm. We are asking staff and students to run or walk 5 km or 12.5 laps of the track, for two very worthwhile causes.

The purpose of this fun run is to raise money for Caritas, St. Joseph's Pastoral Centre and Comfort Cases UK.

Caritas St. Joseph's assist parishes to find and reach out to people with intellectual disabilities and to help them to find a place at the heart of the parish. They support people with intellectual disabilities, their families and friends.

Comfort Cases UK aim is to inspire communities to bring dignity and hope to youth in foster care. On any given day, there are over 108,000 children in care looked after away from home in the UK. Most of them are removed from their homes with little more than the clothes on their backs with an estimated 30,000 moved around the system every year. Many have little except for the clothes on their backs. If they do have any personal belongings, they often don't even have their own bag in which to carry them. This year, we hope to raise enough money to provide some comfort cases for these children in need.

We are asking for your support in this event. You can help by:

- Registering your son to run in the fun run.
- Sponsoring a runner.

Here are some additional details about how to enter the fun run:

The cost to register is a minimum of £10 sponsorship per person. Students will enter the fun run by paying the entry fee on Parent Pay. The pupil will then be given a sponsorship form and an entry number. The £10 entry fee will go towards their fundraising individual fundraising total. Registration will open on Monday 26th June.

There will be prizes for the top finishers in each age group and for the form groups who raise the most money. We hope to see many boys take part in the fun run for a worthwhile cause. All proceeds from the fun run will be split to our chosen charities.

There are a limited number of places available, therefore if you would like your son to participate in the Charity Fun Run, please make a £10 payment on Parent Pay.

Please note that by making the online payment you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions associated with this event and give permission for your son:

To travel to Bannisters Outdoor Stadium at 3:10pm on Wednesday, July 19th, 2023 by public transport.

To attend this trip to be given a mild painkiller, such as paracetamol if considered necessary by the party leader.

To receive medical treatment in an emergency situation if as a parent/carer you are not contactable.

You confirm that we have up to date medical details for your son and you will inform us in writing of any amendments between now and the trip that any medication required is bought with them, such as asthma inhalers and epi-pens.

That you understand that if your son's behaviour in school is not acceptable then he may be withdrawn from the trip and any monies paid to date will not be refunded.

As with all school events, pupils are expected to behave in line with the School Code of Conduct.

Failure to adhere to these expectations will result in sanctions. Good behaviour and academic progress are a pre-requisite to attending this trip and failure to meet the school's expectations will result in the place being withdrawn.
