Admissions Consultation: Salvatorian College

The Salvatorian College Academy Trust would like to give notice of proposed changes to the school's Admissions Policy for the 2025-26 academic year.

Background

The Salvatorian College Academy Trust would like to share proposals for the expansion of the Sixth Form at Salvatorian College, to give notice of changes to the school's Admissions Policy for the 2025-26 academic year, and to enable stakeholders to review and comment on these proposed changes.

The school's 2024-2025 capacity for Years 12 and 13 is currently 50 places for internal students who transfer to the Sixth Form from Year 11.

This consultation concerns the proposal of the Directors of the Salvatorian College Academy Trust to add capacity to the school's existing Sixth Form provision to meet parental and local demand. We are proposing to increase our sixth form capacity for 2025-26 from 50 to 200 and to set a Published Admissions Number (PAN) of 20 for the admission of external candidates who meet our academic entry criteria in Year 12. All students in Year 11 at Salvatorian College who meet the minimum academic entry requirements will have the option to continue into the Sixth Form if they wish. External applicants will be admitted up to the PAN.

The expansion has two aims: firstly, to ensure more quality choice for students and parents at Year 12; and, secondly, to allow female students to benefit from the Sixth Form education that we provide.

The oversubscription criteria per the Admissions Policy, available at the link below, will apply if we have more applications than places available for external students who meet our academic entry criteria.

The Admissions Authority invites comments on the proposed changes to the Admissions Policy for Salvatorian College.





We will be consulting with various groups in accordance with the Admissions Code; to include:

- parents of children between the ages of two and eighteen;
- other persons in the relevant area who in the opinion of the admission authority have an interest in the proposed admissions;
- all other admission authorities within the relevant area;
- the local authority ;
- the Diocese of Westminster.

The consultation period will open on **Thursday, 7th December 2023** and will end on **Wednesday, 31st, January 2024**.
